

Assumptions for Emission-Free Electricity InfoGraphic

1. "Emission-free" refers to any generating source that does not produce emissions of CO₂, NO_X, or SO₂ during its operations. The fuels that fit this category are: nuclear, hydro, wind, solar and geothermal.
2. Percentages are based on annual generation from these sources for 2008.
