WHEREAS, pursuant to a recent article in a national publication, several of the largest nuclear operators and reactor vendors have been holding meetings; and

WHEREAS, it was stated in said publication that as a result of their meetings, a new consortium called "NuStart Energy" has been formed; and

WHEREAS, the goal of NuStart Energy is to choose two (2) of five (5) sites for new reactors by September, 2005, and to begin the permitting process at that time; and

WHEREAS, the Oswego, NY area is already host to three (3) nuclear plants; and

WHEREAS, as the Oswego, NY area has a highly-trained and skilled work force, who have proven themselves capable of building and maintaining the three (3) existing power plants; and

WHEREAS, the Oswego County Building Trades Council by unanimous vote have supported this resolution; and

WHEREAS, this project would create several thousand construction jobs and hundreds of long-term permanent jobs, bringing an economic boom to the Oswego area; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that this administration and Common Council as a show of support do hereby pass this memorializing resolution as a commitment to fully support and diligently work toward locating this plant in the Oswego area; and be it further

RESOLVED that this administration and Common Council will cooperatively work with NuStart Energy, or any of their partners and affiliates, in any way we can to assist in the site selection process; and be it finally

RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to our County, State and Federal elected representatives, encouraging those leaders to support our efforts, as well as to NuStart Energy, Constellation Energy and Entergy.
