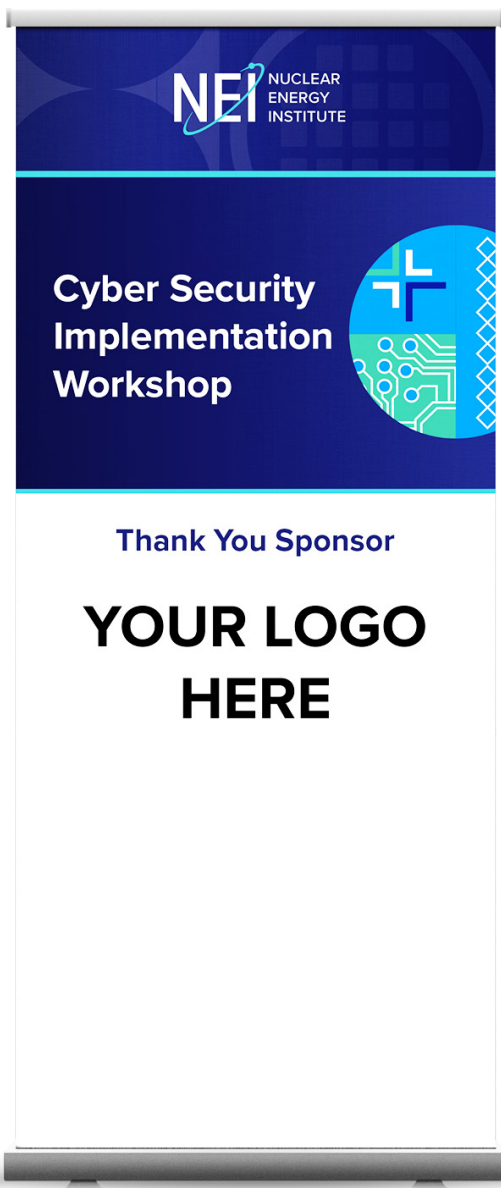

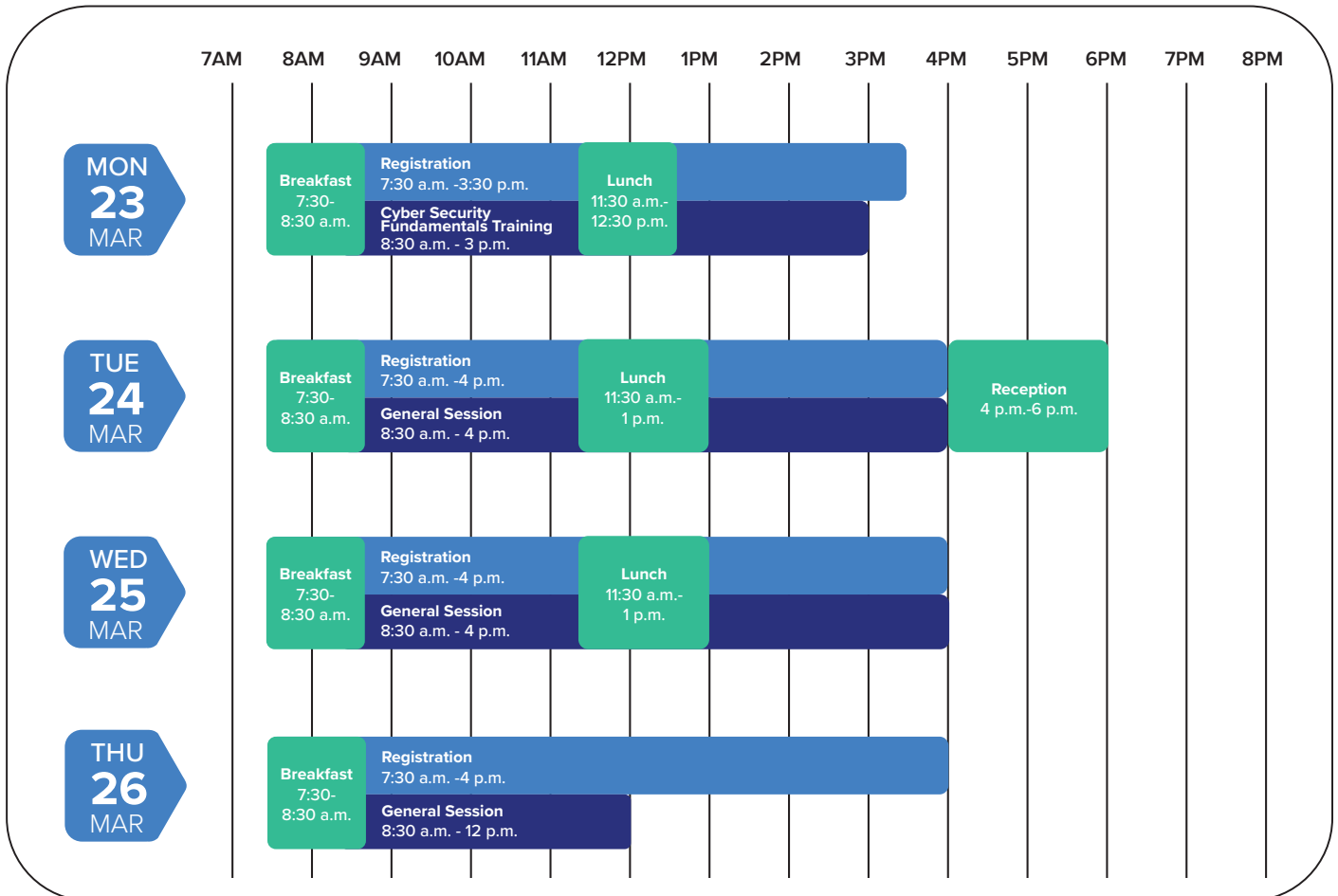

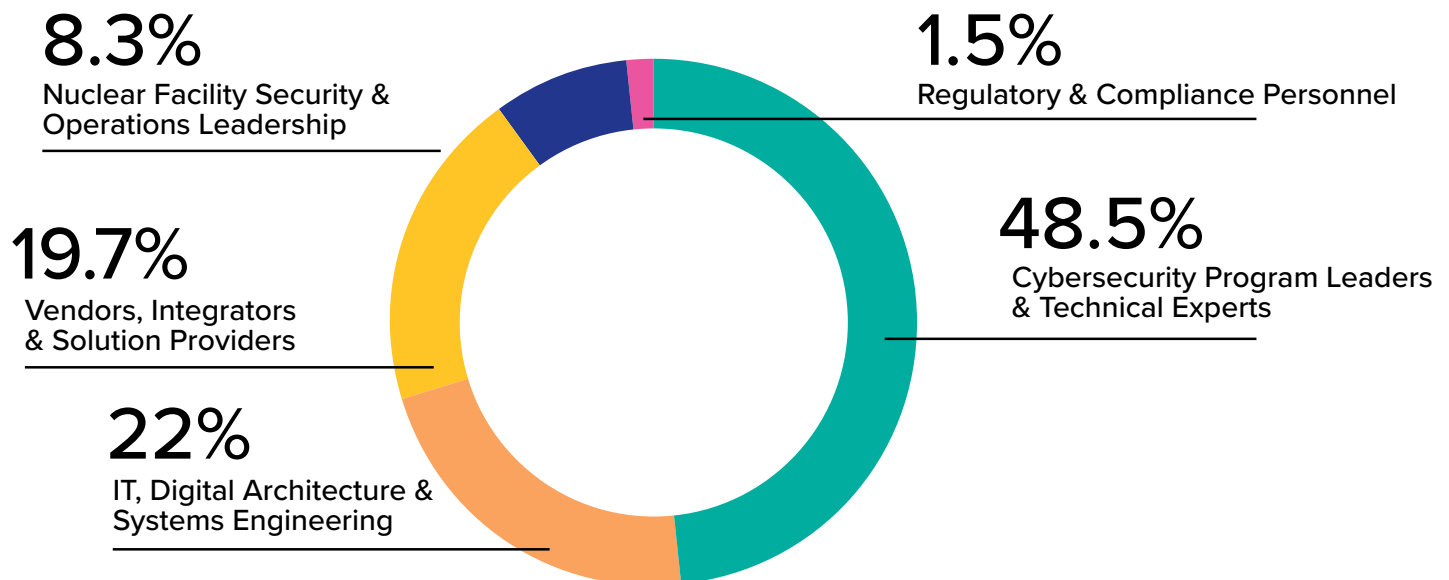
CSIW 2025 at a Glance

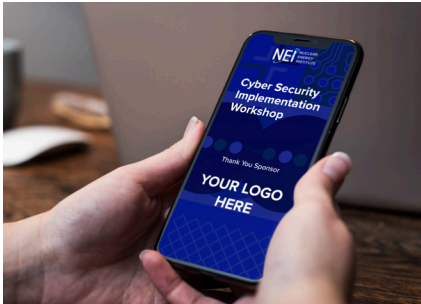

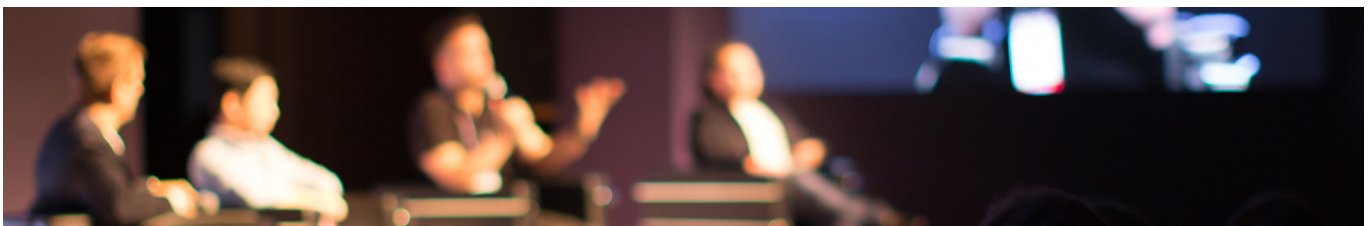
